Kids Learn to Cook (ages 7 to 10)

This camp, directed by Penn State Beaver chefs, will provide hands-on cooking lessons for children in a deliciously fun and educational way. Campers will have the opportunity to explore the campus' Bistro and the industrial cooking equipment used there. Family members are welcome to attend at the end of the last day.

Kid's Cooking: Mystery Basket Challenge (ages 11 to 14)

Directed by Penn State Beaver chefs, campers will work as parts of teams and individually to complete daily mystery basket challenges—just like those featured on their favorite cooking shows! This camp provides hands-on cooking lessons illustrating food and kitchen tools safety. Family members are welcome to attend at the end of the last day.

Crime Scene Investigation (ages 9 to 14)

Role-play as detectives and scientists working in teams to investigate a simulated crime scene. Campers will analyze clues and learn to use forensic techniques to collect evidence and interpret situations. Campers also will use mathematical deduction and scientific reasoning skills to solve the crime.

Ingenious Science (ages 6 to 10)
