
Step 1: Accessing Skyward Grading Categories

To begin, log into Skyward.

Then click on "Teacher Access" [1]

In the dropdown, click on "My Gradebook" [**2**]


Then when you are at your gradebook screen, click "Gradebook" next to any class [3]



Once you are in the gradebook for that class, click the "Categories" tab at the top of the screen.



On the "Category Maintenance" screen, click "Add/Edit Categories".

Go to the course where you want to add the categories.


Then:

- 4. Then click "Save" to add the group



Step 4: Using Weighted Grades in Canvas and Skyward




If you use a weighted gradebook in Skyward weights must be set up in Canvas to align. To weigh grades in Canvas...

- Click "Assignment Groups Weight"




The Assignment Groups Weight box will appear. Here you will put the percentages of the weights for each Assignment Group. These will need to match Skyward.

- 2. Put your percentages in the boxes next to the groups
- 3. Click "Save" when you are finished

Syncing Grades In Canvas

To sync grades from Canvas to Skyward, go to the course in Canvas with the grades you would like to sync.

Click "Grades" option in the Course Navigation.
