The West Allegheny School District continues to welcome new members into its Gold Card Club. While previously available only to senior citizens age 60 and above living in the district, membership was extended to include board members who either completed their term or left the board and retired staff members. If you are at least age 60 and live in the West Allegheny School District, you may pick up a gold card at the district office located at Wilson Elementary School, Monday - Friday, 8:30 am - 3:30 pm. Please bring a driver's license or other proof of age and residence.

The Gold Card entitles members to attend all school district-sponsored activities for which there is normally a charge. These events include a variety of concerts, plays, science fairs, art shows, and regular season athletic activities. Special events, including a December holiday breakfast and a luncheon in conjunction with the spring musical production, are also included in member benefits. Membership does not, however, provide free admission to fund-raising events, post-season athletic events or other activities sponsored by booster organizations.
