Educational Trip. Upon receipt of a <u>written</u> request from the parent/guardian, <u>at least one week in advance</u> of the trip, students may be excused from school attendance to participate in an educational tour or trip provided during the school term at the expense of the parent/guardian <u>when such tour or trip</u> <u>is so evaluated by the school principal</u> and student participants therein are subject to direction and supervision by and adult personage acceptable to the principal and the parent/guardian of the students concerned. <u>If above procedure is not completed, any absence will be considered illegal.</u>
<u>Educational trips are to equal no more than five (5) days in a school year. In addition, trips will not be approved during state standardized testing periods, and/or for students with ten (10) or more absences.</u>
