#### Attendance/Call Off

If your child is going to be absent please call the Middle School Call Off Number or email Mrs. Stewart to inform WAMS of the absence.

Excuses: When your child is absent please send in an excuse within three school days from the date they return, stating the child's first and last name and the reason for the absence. Here is a link to the form you can utilize, Absence Excuse Form. If your child is seen by a medical professional, you can request a note from them to submit to the school. This will code the absence as medical.



# **Early Dismissal**

Please send an email/note in with your child if your child has an early dismissal. The note should indicate the student's first and last name, grade, the date and time of the early release and the purpose of the early release. Please note that because of dismissal routines, any early dismissal must occur prior to 2:15 PM. After that time, please plan on picking your child up in the normal car dismissal line at 2:35pm.

If picking your child up between 7:40am-1:45pm, please pull in front of the Middle School and come to the Main Door with your ID. You will be buzzed into the building and the office staff with check your ID. They will then get your child for dismissal. If you are picking your child up after 1:45pm, please park in the lower parking lot and come to the main door with your ID.

## **Technology Support**

## **School Delays & Cancellations**

West Allegheny School District will delay/close schools for either an emergency or for inclement weather. In the case of emergency situations, students from the impacted school(s) would be instructed to follow the District's Remote Learning Plan. For inclement weather closures, all five West Allegheny schools would be notified if it is a snow day with no classes or a Remote Learning Day after snow days have been exhausted. If it is a Remote Learning Day, students would be directed to log on through Canvas at 9:00 a.m. and follow the designated schedule.

In the case of school delays/closures, West Allegheny will communicate the information via phone, text, Facebook, and the District website as well as KDKA, WTAE and WPXI TV. # **Educational Trips**

It is preferred that trips take place during breaks or spring break. However, if your family is going on an educational trip, please submit an <u>Educational Trip</u> form at least one week prior to the start of the trip. Educational trips are equal to no more than five (5) days in a school year. In addition, trips will not be approved during state standardized testing period, and/or for students with ten (10) or more absences.
