Please be aware that students or parents will still be required to complete the form no later than 6 p.m. on each remote learning day to account for your child's participation.

Yesterday, Governor Wolf extended the stay-at-home order until April 30 and indicated schools would remain closed indefinitely. With this information, West Allegheny schools will remain closed through at least Friday, May 1. During this extended and indefinite closure, we will continue with the remote learning plan. We will continue to monitor the situation, adapt plans accordingly and keep our families apprised of how these orders impact our remote leaning plans and the school event calendar.
