Summer Enrichment

The West Allegheny Virtual Academy (WAVA) Summer Enrichment program is available to motivated high school students who want to accelerate in coursework during the summer months between school years. Students are expected to work independently. There is no direct teacher instruction; however, teachers monitoring the summer courses may be reached through email with questions.

Summer Enrichment courses are the same online courses provided to students during the school year through WAVA but offered during a condensed window of time. These online courses may fulfill the core subject or elective credits required for graduation. **Students must** have their course requests confirmed by their West Allegheny High School (WAHS) school counselor **and approved** by the WAHS Principal prior to enrollment. Students and parents should plan summer vacations and other activities accordingly to allow students enough time to complete the coursework during the Summer Enrichment period.
