



Construction Status




Construction Status: Timeline



































WAMS School Operations

School Operations: Arrival


- Bus arrival will be in the same location, in the front of the building.
 Students will enter through the existing main entrance.
- Parent Drop-Off will turn right at the access road across from the tennis courts.
 - You will no longer be able to loop behind the building. Please follow the flow of traffic and staff will direct you where to go.
 - TO AVOID DELAYS, WE ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGING STUDENTS TO RIDE THE SCHOOL BUS.
- **Student Driver Riders** will park in the lower parking lot, walk up the stairs and cross with a staff member's direction. They will walk up the sidewalk to the existing main entrance.

Upon arrival, students will go to one of three locations to wait for the first bell.

- 8th Grade: Cafeteria
- **7th Grade:** Gym Bleachers
- **6th Grade:** Gym opposite side of bleachers







School Operations: Morning



- Breakfast is FREE for all students and will be Grab & Go style.
- Students can pick up breakfast in the cafeteria or in the WAMS lobby.



School Operations: Dismissal



- •Bus riders will be dismissed in two waves, which is the same as last year. Students will wait in the assigned pods outside based on the location of their bus. As in all school years, we will have that information and teach that to students the first week of school. Sixth Grade will have time to practice this with their teachers so they are clear on how this works and where to go.
- •Parent Pick-Up Parents will wait in line until after bus dismissal. Parents should not begin lining up in their vehicles until 2:40pm. Parents should turn at the access road across from the tennis courts and remain in their vehicles until staff directs the pick-up line to pull forward. Parents will pull in front of the Middle School after buses depart to pick up their child.
- •TO AVOID DELAYS, WE ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGING STUDENTS TO RIDE THE SCHOOL BUS.
- •Student Driver Riders Students will be dismissed and will walk down the sidewalk to a designated staff member. When directed, students will cross the drive and walk down the sidewalk and into the student driver's vehicle.



School Operations: Classroom Assignments

- Morning Locations: Upon arrival, students will go to one of three locations to wait for the first bell.
 - 8th Grade: Cafeteria
 - **7th Grade:** Gym Bleachers
 - **6th Grade:** Gym opposite side of bleachers

Band

For the first 2-3 weeks of school, Band will be utilizing one quadrant of the gymnasium for band class. There are dividers and temporary dividers to designate this space.

Chorus

For the first 2-3 weeks of school, Chorus will meet their teacher/staff member in the WAMS Lobby and walk to the High School Chorus Room. A staff member will also bring them back from the High School.

Pre-Engineering

For the first 3-4 weeks, Pre-Engineering will be held in room 111.

Innovation and Design

For the first 3-4 weeks, Innovation and Design will be held in room B103.

School Operations: Lockers and Cellphones

- Lockers will <u>not</u> be available for the 2023-24 school year. Students will keep their condensed supplies in their backpack and their backpacks will be with them throughout the school day.
- Staff will designate an area inside their classroom where backpacks can be placed during that period.
- Coats and/or sweatshirts will be carried or placed in student backpacks.
- Cell phones should be silent and away and kept in students' backpacks at all times during the school day. Students are not permitted to use cell phones at the Middle School during the school day.
- In the cafeteria, there will be a location for backpacks to be kept while students are eating lunch. No cellphones are to be used during lunch.



School Operations: Additional Items


Announcements
