Attendance/Call Off

If your child is going to be absent please call the Wilson Call Off Number or email the teacher and Ms. DeFazio to inform them of the absence.

Excuses

When your child is absent, please send in an <u>Excuse for Absence Form</u> within 3 school days from the date they return, stating the child's first and last name and the reason for the absence. If your child is seen by a medical professional, you can request a note from them to submit to the school. This will code the absence as medical.



Early Dismissal

Please send an <u>Early Dismissal Form</u> in with your child if your child will be leaving school early. The note should indicate the student's first and last name, the name of the homeroom, as well as the date, time and purpose of the early release.

When you arrive, please call the main office at **724-695-3300** to inform the office that you have arrived to pick up your child. Our school staff will walk your child out and check for identification.

Student pick-up in the front of the building can only occur prior to 2:45 p.m., due to dismissal/bus traffic. After that time, please plan on picking your child up from the pick-up line at 3:20 pm.

School Delays & Cancellations
